STS 50m 3P Grand Prix Series 2024

Programme

The meeting is a 50m squadded smallbore (.22) 3 positions event that is run on electronic targets. This event will consist of

- 3 x 20 shot competition for men
- 3 x 20 shot competition for women

The competitions are shot concurrently.

The ISSF final will be a combined final.

The ISSF final will follow the current ISSF format as best as can be achieved with the number of competitors entered in the competition. How this will be run will be determined on the day of the event.

Event Rules

The meeting will be run under ISSF rules as far as possible. <u>Application of ISSF rules for equipment control will be advisory only.</u> The Range Jury will consist of any three people from the organising committee and/or the STS Smallbore AMG.

Grand Prix series points will only be awarded to athletes who qualify for the final and compete in the final.

Shooters with a Disability

Eligibility to Enter

Since this event is run following ISSF rules, in general it is not open to competitors with a disability unless the competitor is able to comply with these rules.

Venue Accessibility

The 50m range at both Denwood and Alloa is accessible to mobility impaired and wheelchair shooters with help from club members to negotiate the paths to the range. An accessible toilet is available at the Denwood indoor range which has step free access. There is no accessible toilet at the Alloa range.

Scoring and Points

Points for both the men's 3 x 20 and the women's 3 x 20 events will be awarded on the competitor's relative position in the ISSF final as shown in the points table below.
