All STS Events Have Now Been Cancelled Until January 2021!

STS has taken the difficult decision to cancel all physical competitions for the rest of 2020 due to the need for clubs to focus on re-opening.

We know this will be disappointing to many but our competitions will return but for now, member safety and supporting clubs to re-open at a pace they feel comfortable with must be the priority.

However, we are reviewing whether to run postal competitions during this time, aware that many will not be able to enter if their clubs do not open. We shall wait for the survey responses to see what interest there is likely to be before deciding whether to run postal competitions this winter.

Update on Scottish Government COVID-19 Guidance

On 20 August the First Minister confirmed that Scotland would remain in Phase 3 but from 31 August indoor sports facilities, including ranges can re-open. The subsequent updated on 10 September saw the tightening of social restrictions but organised sport has been highlighted as being exempt. Now that indoor ranges can consider opening, we are launching two surveys—one for clubs and one for individuals.
