Home Office Firearms Safety Consultation Closes on 16 February

As mentioned in our newsletter at the start of the year, don't forget about the consultation currently open with the Home Office regarding firearms safety that closes this month.

This consultation seeks views on the following firearms safety issues which were raised with the Government during the passage of the Offensive Weapons Act 2019 through Parliament:

- High muzzle energy rifles
- Air weapons (not relevant for Scotland)
- Miniature rifle ranges
- Components of ammunition

STS will be submitting a response but would also encourage members to respond too. Don't forget that the deadline for responding is 16 February 2021! See the Home Office outline and respond online

Athlete Awareness Tool

STS recommends that clubs share this tool with their members so that all over the age of 13 use this tool if they or their children are participating in sport or physical activity training, competitions or other events.
