Shooting News

STS Memberships for 2022 Available NOW

STS membership for both clubs and individuals for 2022 are NOW available to allow these to be purchased in advance so they can continue seamlessly on 1st January 2022. Prices are unchanged from 2021 rates, with juniors and people with a disability continuing to receive half price rates. COVID-19 Guidance: Omicron Update

We wanted to provide members with an update following the announcement made by the First Minister on Tuesday 14 December with regards the latest threat posed by the Omicron variant of COVID-19 and the Scottish Government's response to this.

At this stage, the First Minister's request for caution and limiting socialising to three households around the festive season relates to social settings and the hospitality sector. Currently, there are no additional specific restrictions (advised or otherwise) put in place by Scottish Government relating to the sporting sector (although for mass spectator sports, clearly some restrictions on spectator numbers will likely apply) but:

- Individuals are reminded to continue to observe the following of safety measures already in place to limit the spread of the virus, including social distancing, wearing face masks when indoors (except when 'on the field of play' e.g. on the range), washing hands, wiping down surfaces and most importantly, not visiting clubs if they test positive, someone in their household tests positive or they have demonstrate any symptoms of the virus; and
- Clubs continue to operate a booking system for range time so athlete numbers can be managed, any positive cases can be tracked and traced, ventilation is maximised, one way systems are followed and maximum numbers for areas within clubs are constantly reviewed.

As such, for the time being, STS does not see a need to update its COVID guidance as it already includes guidance on the above steps. However, we fully accept that clubs may wish to put in place additional restrictions to limit numbers in clubhouses, on the range and any other areas in the club. While further restrictions are not required as things currently stand (as of 16/12/21), STS fully supports clubs taking measures for the protection of members, if they feel such steps are necessary. It will be for each club to assess it's facilities and membership and come to a decision about what action is best to take.

Finally, the Scottish Government is constantly monitoring the spread of Omicron and reviewing the guidance on a daily basis. Therefore, **rules are subject to change at very short notice**, **especially over the festive season**. STS will do its best to keep members up to date, but with staff on leave over the festive season, updates may take some time to be communicated. It is therefore advised that clubs and individuals continue to monitor the <u>Scottish Government's COVID-19 website pages</u> for any updates to regulations and requirements.

At the start of 2022, we will be looking to review our COVID guidance document to see if any updates, changes or simplifications can be made to keep the document as brief, informative and relevant as possible.

Police Scotland Advises Clubs with Renewals Due in 2022 to Submit Applications Early

STS has been contacted by Police Scotland to advise that in 2022 they will be faced with a large number of club renewals which may lead to some delays or longer than usual processing times. As such, Police Scotland have asked us to advise clubs that if they are due for renewal in 2022, please consider getting applications in early to ensure applications can be processed in time.

Clubs should be aware that delays, while not requiring clubs to cease functioning or close it doors pending renewal, do mean that certain activities will not be allowed until such time as the renewal is confirmed.

The Scottish Government have been asked to issue similar advice and if we get any more updates from Police Scotland around processing times, we will be sure to pass these on to our member clubs.

STS Adopts UKAD Anti-Doping Rules to Keep Shooting Clean

As part of the STS's commitment to making sure the sport of shooting is clean from grassroots to performance, the Board has now adopted the <u>UKAD Anti-Doping Rules</u> to ensure there is a consistent approach taken and we hold ourselves accountable to the highest standards.

As a result of the work we are doing with UKAD, STS is reviewing its Competition Conduct document that applies to all those competing in STS events (members and non-members) and/or representing STS at competitions (whether part of the performance programme or not). We will issue this in early 2022.

We all have a role to play in ensuring Clean Shooting to make sure shooting remains an inclusive, friendly, drug-free, safe sport to be part of.
