STS 2022 AGM

STS is pleased to confirm that it delivered a quorate AGM on 23 April 2022. At the meeting, Ian Thomson was re-elected to the Sport Vice Chair position and both motions proposed by the Board were carried by a majority vote. Sadly, with no nominations, the Bob Aitken Service to Shooting Award was not presented for 2022 but is reopening for nominations (see below). Also, with no nominations for the Business Vice Chair or Field Target Airgun AMG Chair positions, these have also gone back out to advert (links to these at the bottom of this e-newsletter) and we hope to have these positions filled by our 2023 AGM.

Scottish Success at Round 1 of the British Shotgun Series

British Shooting held round 1 of their 2022 shotgun series on 2nd and 3rd April 2022. Athletes from Scotland travelled down to Beverley, East Yorkshire and for many of the athletes from the STS performance programme, it proved a successful trip.

Headlining STS success, **Keith White** won Gold and **Mike Drever** Bronze in the Para Trap event. As a result of their recent good form, both Keith and Mike have been selected by British Shooting to represent Great Britain at the upcoming WSPS World Cups in France and Germany.

Although they didn't medal, young STS athletes **Isabelle MacKintosh** (OT) and **Thomas McCarle** (OSK) both achieved places in their respective finals, which is a great achievement and valuable experience for these young Scots competing at their first British Shooting event.

Scottish performances earlier that weekend saw **Ewen Patience** score 111, **Ewen Ross** score 106, **Drew Christie** score 103, **Chris Sockalingam** score 92, Isabelle MacKintosh score 91 and Mike Drever score 91 in the Olympic Trap qualification rounds while **David McNeill** scored 113, **Richard Brooks** 105 and Thomas McCarle 103 in the Olympic Skeet qualification rounds.
