#### STS 2023 AGM on 29 April 2023

This is a reminder that the STS will be holding the 2023 AGM on Saturday 29 April 2023.

In recognition of the value of meeting members face-to-face, but also the geographical spread of our members, the AGM will be held as a hybrid meeting, allowing people to attend both in person and online. The location of the meeting will be Caledonia House, Edinburgh for those wishing to attend.

#### We Need Your Nominations for the AMG Chair Positions by 31 March

It is therefore crucial that we do all we can to explain the importance of these roles and encourage members with an interest to stand.

#### How Important is Licence Revocation Cover to You?

Currently all individual members of STS receive Licence Revocation cover that essentially means you can claim for legal costs should your Firearm, Shotgun or Air Weapon Certificate be revoked and you proceed to challenge this decision.

In 2023, the cost for us providing this to members increased dramatically with very little prior notice. As things stand, it is not sustainable for STS to keep offering this cover as part of our membership meaning we either need to significantly increase membership fees from 2024 or remove this product from our membership packages immediately or at the end of the year.

The Board of STS therefore want to ask the opinions of our members to determine how best to proceed by seeing how important this is to you. If you haven't already done so, please complete this very short survey to give us your views.
