Shooting News

STS Responds to Key Shooting Consultations

The following key consultations, with an impact on the shooting community, closed on 23 August:

Home Office Firearms Licensing Consultation

The Home Office published on 29 June a consultation which closed on 23 August. It covered a number of recommendations it has received on suggested changes to firearms licensing. The consultation seeks views on recommendations made to the UK Government by a number of committees.

Scottish Government Permitted Development Rights Review Consultation

A consultation on Permitted Development Rights was published by the Scottish Government on the 31 May which closed on 23 August. It contained a section that covers Temporary Use of Land: Shooting Ranges. Section 6.2 and Question 30 of the consultation relate to the particular issue of 'Shooting Ranges'.

In summary, the Scottish Government were seeking views on proposals to remove an exemption which allows temporary use of land for up to 28 days per calendar year, without planning permission, from applying to shooting ranges for fixed targets. <u>See the responses to both consultations provided by STS</u>
